QUEENSLAND LIGHTING DESIGN & INNOVATION AWARDS.

Website entry forms have now been released for 2021. This year entries are open for both 2020 & 2021 submissions.

The 2021 LiDA application process is 100% online. The process has been simplified as follows:

- The applicant pays for the entry via credit card or can request an invoice. Once payment is complete the applicant is free to start the entry
- There is one text field of unlimited characters to explain why the project is award worthy
- Up to 10 pictures can be uploaded
- A URL link to a video can be included
- Up to 5 team credits can be included
- The applicant must select at least one category from Installation, Technology, Application. But they can select more than one.
- The entry form can be saved and revisited unlimited times until it is submitted, at which point it can't be edited.
