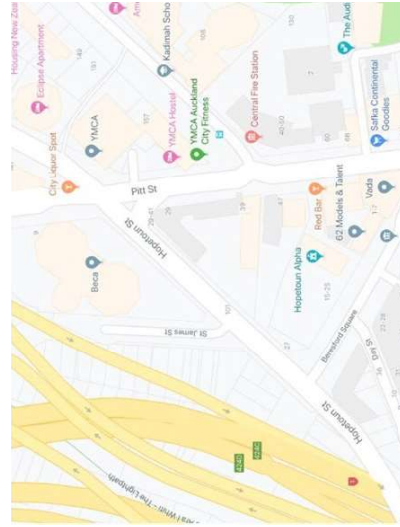

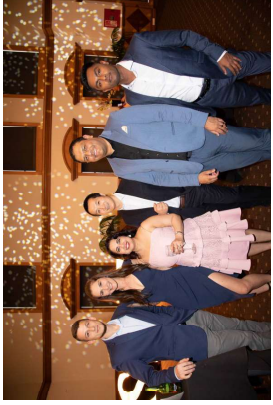
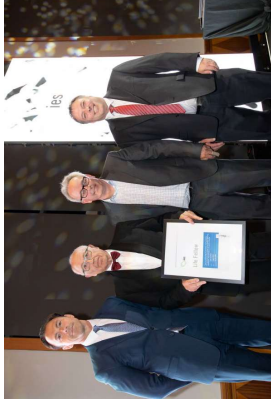

Year 1: Sylvia Wei

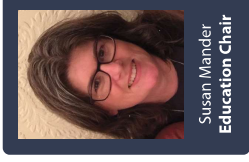
Year 2: Ross Farrell

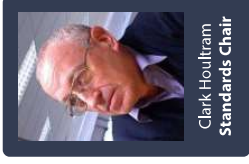

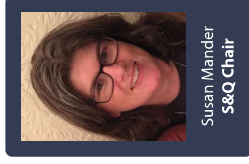
Status & Qualifications

I'm stepping down from this role in the coming year, but am sure that the new S&Q coordinator will welcome your queries.

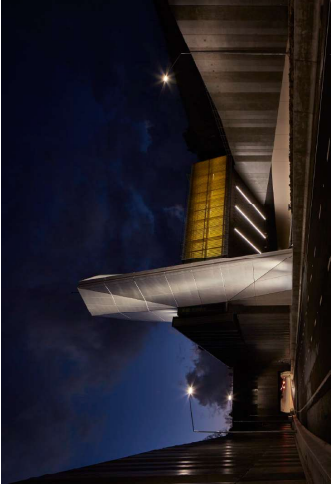
